



Staying in touch with your child's learning!

One of the major benefits of Digital Learning is the use of Showbie. Children in years 2-6 access most of their learning through Showbie at school and as a parent/carer you can access their account on any internet-enabled device (including a phone). This will allow you to see most of their lesson slides and assignments to see exactly what they are doing in class.

This provides an incredible opportunity for any parents wishing to actively support their child at home: looking at concepts again, addressing misconceptions, discussing topics or to simply see what they have been up to!



1. First, sign up for Showbie and Create a Parent Account.
2. Enter your child's parent code (these will be given out)
3. In your parent account, tap the + button, then enter the code, and lastly tap 'Add'
