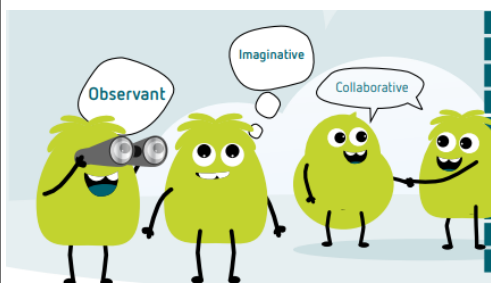

This year's theme

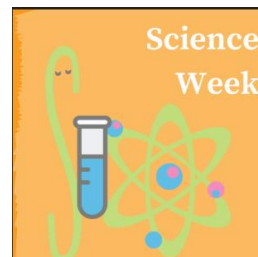
Each year there is a new theme for British Science Week and for 2026 it's 'Curiosity: what's your question?'

This year's theme is all about putting our South Wilford Children in the driving seat and bravely finding answers to the pressing questions they have about the world.

Curiosity is at the heart of Science and will drive our children to be the next innovators in traditional science or music, sport, architecture.



Starting on Monday 9th March until Friday 13th March All year groups will use their observation skills and imagination to collaboratively answer questions about what they see in the world.



Throughout the week there is so much to look forward to and get involved in!

- **Tuesday 10th March** Science Assembly led by our curriculum leaders. We will be asking questions about the world we live in and answering them using our investigation skills and some thrilling experiments.
- Ever wondered how something works? What something is made of? Or why something goes bang? You ask, **our curriculum leader's answer**. Find our question box on the Science display and write down a question you have about ANYTHING. We will pick three questions to answer during our Science week Assembly. Questions have to be in by Thursday 5th of March.
