A whopping **180 books** were swapped and **118 second hand** books were bought.

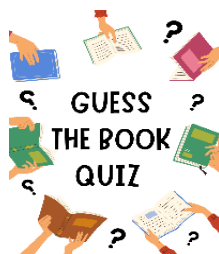
We've put the money raised straight into buying new books for school and through buying at the charity shops have managed to get a great selection of books children are desperate to read.
