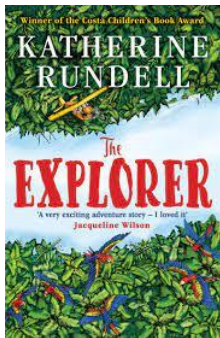
What are we up to this term in Year 5?
