Our school has been invited to take part in a competition to design an official Christmas card for our local MP Lilian Greenwood. In addition to being the school's local MP, Lilian Greenwood is now also Minister for Local Transport, and her responsibilities include cycling, walking, taxis and road safety. The competition is open to all children in all the primary schools and the winning design will be chosen by a panel of judges. If your child would like to be involved, please ensure that:

- All designs are drawn or painted on an A4 sheet of white paper
- Designs **do not** have any glitter or stuck on elements
- Designs **should be** bold and bright, as this works best in the printing process
- Each entry includes the entrant's name, age, and school name on the back of their design



The challenge for this year's Christmas card competition is to **design a card inspired by local transport and road safety**. The children are encouraged to have fun and let their imaginations run wild to produce a design which is both bold and bright.
